

## CASA RELIEF WORK IN WAYANAD DISTRICT



Wayanad, also known as 'The land of paddy fields', is one of the most backward districts of India. It had been hit with heavy rains since 8th August. The district has been flooded mainly because of the release of water from Banasura Sagar and Karapuzha Dam and has been under continuous red alert. The number of people at the relief camps reached over 24,000. The agrarian district has suffered crop loss to the tune of Rs 70 crore, according to reports.

While Kerala remains under the yellow alert due to predicted heavy rainfall, CASA continues to reach out to the affected families. Our teams from across the nation are stationed at the most required areas of Kerala including Wayanad and are dedicatedly distributing the relief material. The real challenge post rescue and relief in the aftermath of Kerala flood is of rebuilding and rehabilitation. CASA starts its intervention in Wayanad district with increased staff capacity and resources to help people come back to
